



CODE OF CONDUCT

Laserzone Brisbane requires that all players, staff, officials / referees and Administrators must:

- Behave honestly and with integrity in connection with the Brisbane Rumble;
- Act with care and diligence in connection with the Brisbane Rumble;
- When acting in connection with with the Brisbane Rumble, treat everyone with respect and courtesy, and without harassment;
- When acting in connection with with the Brisbane Rumble, comply with all applicable Rules and Regulations;
- Comply with any lawful and reasonable direction given by someone in the Brisbane Rumble who has authority to give the direction ie: Referees / Administrators
- Maintain appropriate confidentiality when required about dealings with the Brisbane Rumble Administration and organisers;
- Take reasonable steps to avoid any conflict of interest (real or apparent) and disclose details of any material personal interest in connection with the Brisbane Rumble;
- If required use the resources of Laserzone Brisbane in a proper manner and for a proper purpose only;
- Not provide false or misleading information in response to a request for information that is made for official purposes in connection with with the Brisbane Rumble;
- Not improperly use inside information or utilise the duties, status, power or authority of the Brisbane Rumble:
 1. to gain, or seek to gain, a benefit or an advantage for oneself or any other person; or
 2. to cause, or to seek to cause, detriment to Laserzone Brisbane, the Brisbane Rumble or any other person in connection with the Brisbane Rumble
- Whilst, playing administrating, officiating or attending the Brisbane Rumble, at all times behave in a way that upholds the good reputation of Laserzone Brisbane and the Brisbane Rumble and
- Comply with any other conduct requirement that is prescribed by Laserzone Brisbane or the Brisbane Rumble

Photographs and Video Consent, Waiver, Indemnity and Release

Photographs, Videos and Recordings

I hereby grant permission to Laserzone Brisbane and its representatives to take photographs or videos of me and to make recordings of my voice during this event or at any official location associated with the event.

I further grant to the producers and their representatives the right to reproduce, use, exhibit, display, broadcast and distribute and create derivative works of these images and recordings in any media now known or later Developed. I acknowledge that Zone Laser Tag Australasian Championships maintains all rights to the images and recordings.

Waiver, Indemnity and Release

I hereby waive any right to inspect or approve the use of the images or recordings or of any written copy. I also waive any right to royalties or other compensation arising from or related to the use of the images, recordings, or materials. I hereby release, defend, indemnify and hold harmless the producers from and against any claims, damages or liability arising from or related to the use of the images, recordings or materials, including but not limited to claims of defamation, invasion of privacy, or rights of publicity or copyright infringement, or any misuse, distortion, blurring, alteration, optical illusion or use in composite form that may occur or be produced in taking, processing, reduction or production of the finished product, its publication or distribution. I am 18 years of age or older and I am competent to contract in my own name. I have read this document before signing below, and I fully understand the contents, meaning and impact of this consent, waiver, indemnity and release. This consent, waiver, indemnity and release is binding on me, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.

I further understand it is a condition of entry into the Brisbane Rumble that my image will be used on scoreboards and player profiles that will be streamed live and will be recorded during the event. I further understand any refusal to have these images displayed may result in my player registration being consider invalid.

Consent, Waiver, Indemnity and Release

1. I the "Player", wish to enter the Brisbane Rumble ("Event")
2. I the 'Player' acknowledge that playing laser tag and by engaging in the sport and participating in the Event the I the player, takes and is exposed to certain risks and dangers including but not pertaining to the below:
 - (a) I the 'Player' may be injured, physically or mentally
 - (b) other competitors may play in a dangerous manner or with lack of skill;
 - (c) arena or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
 - (d) the Organisers, officials, landowners/arena operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of the Event are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time and/or events;
 - (e) entrants including the 'player' have an obligation to themselves and to others to compete safely and within the rules of competition.
3. In consideration of the Organiser's accepting the 'Player' as an entrant in the Event the 'Player' agrees to indemnify the Organisers and each of them in the following manner:

- (a) that I the 'Player' participates in the event at my/our sole risk and responsibility;
- (b) that I the 'Player' accepts the venue as it stands with all or any defects hidden or exposed;
- (c) that I the 'Player' indemnify and hold harmless the Organisers, their respective servants, agents or officials against any actions or claims which may be made by I the 'Player' or on my behalf or by other parties for or in respect of or arising out of the I the 'Player' death or any injury loss or damage caused to the I the 'Player' whether caused by negligence or in any other manner whatsoever.
4. I the 'Player' release & forever discharge the Organisers from all Claims that I may have or may have had but for this release arising from or in connection with this deed or from the I the 'Player' participation in the Event.
5. I the 'Player' declare that the I the 'Player' is medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Event.
6. I the 'Player' authorise the Organisers to direct the I the 'Player' not to participate in the Event if participation constituted an unacceptable risk of causing I the 'Player' harm, injury or death.
7. I the 'player' have read and understood the rules as written in the Rule Book
